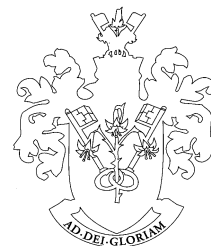

FORM OF CONSENT OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN FOR PUPILS' PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL ORGANISED EDUCATIONAL OR HOLIDAY/RECREATIONAL VISIT

If my daughter/son is offered a place on any visit I will sign the specific visit form and, in doing so, agree to abide by this 'form of consent' at all times.

1. If a place is available, I agree:
 - (a) to pay to you my share of any expenditure which, as organiser of the School party, you may incur
 - (b) to pay to you on account, a deposit of £
2. I understand that the deposit is not returnable unless:
 - (a) I cancel the place before you incur any expenses or enter into any commitments, or
 - (b) You cancel the visit for any reason and some money remains after meeting expenses and commitments
3. I also agree that if the visit is cancelled for any unavoidable reason, I will pay my share of the cost of meeting all expenses and commitments where this is not covered by my deposit, nor by insurance.
4. I also agree to authorise members of staff during the course of the visit to approve such medical treatment for my child as is deemed necessary in an emergency on the advice of a qualified medical practitioner. I set out on the attached form any medical condition, from which my child is suffering, together with details of the treatment required.
5. The school will provide written details explaining supervision arrangements for the specific visit and I accept by signing the specific visit letter I am accepting these arrangements.
6. In addition, by signing the specific visit form, I consent to my daughter/son/ward taking part in the activities of the visit, which will be explained to me when the specific visit letter is sent.
7. School Code of conduct on residential visits.

Code of Conduct

Any student detected in gross misbehaviour will be sent home at her/his parents' expense.

Gross misbehaviour will include:

- a. Supply, possession or use of drugs
- b. Consumption or possession of alcohol
- c. Sexual misbehaviour
- d. Dangerous behaviour, which puts others at risk
- e. Behaviour likely to bring the School's name into disrepute

Should any student need to be sent home the school staff will contact her/his family to inform them of the circumstances and the arrangements. Parents will be charged for the journey.

A full report of any such occurrence will be written for the Headteacher and Governors who will decide on any further action necessary.
